PROGRAM OVERVIEW

We have 4 first, 4 second, & 4 third year positions. One 3rd year resident will spend the 3rd year in San Diego, splitting time between Scripps Mercy San Diego, Kaiser San Diego, Scripps Green & Sharp Rees Stealy. 2 residents will spend their 3rd year at Kaiser Program in Sacramento. One 3rd yr resident will spend their 3rd year at Kaiser Program in Fontana/Ontario. (Riverside Co in Southern California) We have rotations at Kaiser San Diego (7 pod surg attendings), Sharp Rees Stealy (6 pod surg) & rotations at Scripps Clinic & Scripps Green Hospital (5 pod surg attendings) besides Scripps Mercy during the 2nd year. There is a strong emphasis on biomechanics as well as surgery and trauma. There are excellent outside rotations as well. The first 2 years are the same. A separate selection category is set up for the 3 different 3rd year spots. (San Diego vs Sacramento vs Fontana/Ontario 3rd year position). The programs will be matched separately by CASPR. You will be able to select each program separately. A single application process and fee is available for each or all 3 programs.
