1st yr residents serve as Surgery Interns, rotating in various specialties. They are treated the same as MD/DO residents with same case load & requirements. 1-month rotations consist of Plastic, Vascular, Trauma, Burn & General Surgery, SICU & Radiology. Few podiatrists get the opportunity to work at a Level I trauma center & the nationally renowned Arizona Burn Center. 1st yr will fulfill all 'off-service' rotation requirements. 2nd & 3rd yr residents rotate through Podiatric & Orthopedic surgery, covering foot & ankle complaints from neonatal to geriatric patients. 2nd & 3rd yr residents work w/ established community podiatrists, increasing exposure to surgical volume, diversity & practice management. 2nd yr residents also have a research curriculum; allowing projects to reach fruition over the 2-yr period remaining. Didactics during yrs 2-3 provide residents w/ experiences to hear, see & practice hands-on. The MIHS Podiatric Residency raises level of training & will elevate your future Podiatric practice. Candidates are judged based on academic background & interview performance.
