PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This is a very well rounded Podiatric Medicine and Surgery residency program. Residents gain experience with forefoot, rearfoot, ankle, and reconstructive surgery. Excellent relationship exists with multiple surgical and medical specialties for additional experience. Clinical exposure is obtained during resident managed Wound Clinic at hospital and at Attendings's offices. This program is an ideal environment for motivated resident. The residents are expected to provide an analysis of all cases based on peer reviewed literature, past experience, and faculty input. This provides a critical analysis of surgical planning, and post op outcomes. Included are M&M meetings, radiology review and chapter reviews. A balance of technical experience and academic advancement.
