**PROGRAM OVERVIEW** 

Program is approved PMSR/RRA.

Program maintains a surgical wet lab that is fully equipped for forefoot, rearfoot & ankle procedures on cadaveric specimens. This includes full arthroscopy capabilities and fluoroscopy. Each resident receives three cadaveric limbs per year to enhance surgical skills, a personal set of surgical instruments. Residents will participate in the clinical case conference webcast which is moderated by faculty. All residents receive memberships to national, state, and local podiatric medical associations as well as ACFAS/ACFOAM. Select residents may have the opportunity to attend microsurgical training and ACFAS learning center courses. The program offers extensive rotations and faculty consists of many ABFAS/ABPOPPM Board Certified podiatrists. Program Library has latest podiatric, orthopedic medicine texts and journals. Past graduates hold leadership roles in many state and national organizations. This creates a networking opportunity for post residency employment.

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
