PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Podiatry residency training program at UTHSCSA has been a fully integrated program within a state funded academic health science center for 44 years. We are a Division of the Department of Orthopaedics. Our faculty includes five full-time faculty and 18 adjunct clinical faculty. Primary locations for training are The University Health System (County Hospital), South Texas Veterans Health Care System, and private hospitals/surgery centers where our clinical faculty in private practice work. Training involves an extensive combination of inpatient and outpatient services with excellent surgical training in limb salvage, plastic surgery, trauma, podopediatrics and reconstructive rearfoot and ankle surgery. Our focus is to train podiatry medical physicians keeping in mind the mission of an academic health center, which is teaching, research, and service.
