The residency program emphasizes the surgical management of diseases and deformities of the foot and ankle, while interacting on a daily basis with the other residents of the institution. Call the Graduate Medical Education office at #773/ 989-3808 for more information or to schedule a visit with the program. Visitation or externship is not mandatory, but preferable. We have accepted students as residents who did and did not visit and rotate thru the program. The first year is spent predominantly on rotations at the hospital with some exposure to podiatric surgery. The last two years have a heavy emphasis on podiatric surgery and occur primarily at the hospital and surgery centers. You are the only surgical residents at the hospital with exposure assisting orthopedic surgeons
