The podiatry staff of DeKalb Medical Center is composed of some of the foremost educators in the profession. Residents are exposed to patients with a large diversity of pathologies and approaches to treatment. We cover a large number of trauma cases from 3 different emergency departments. The hospital experience is supplemented with office clinics in two busy offices and in a charity clinic which is covered by the residents as well as a wound clinic.
