Beth Israel Deaconess is a primary teaching hospital of Harvard Med School with a level 1 Trauma Center. Residents enjoy access to the extensive libraries on campus, clinical skills labs, and cutting edge lectures in all aspects of medicine, surgery and research. This is a high volume surg prog that provides exposure to all aspects of foot and ankle surgery, including trauma, reconstructive, elective, and diabetic salvage procedures. Residents are expected to manage in-house patients in addition to running a clinic during their 1st year and 3rd year. Chief residents participate in an international mission trip with ample opportunities to gain advanced surgical training. This program is a very hands-on clinical experience with exposure to both Pod & Ortho Attendings. Research opportunities are abundant, including the opportunity to participate in clinical trials, NIH funded research grants, and the necessary support to engage in original research projects.
