The program is multifaceted and well-rounded. Surgical experience includes forefoot, rearfoot and ankle surgery. Resident's are required to have a paper of publishable quality by the time of graduation. There is a wound care center which will provide training and experience in all phases of diabetic wound management, PVD, neurologic conditions, osteomyelitis Charcot reconstruction and limb preservation. The hospitals consist of 3 divisions (Washington Township, Cherry Hill and Stratford) along with the (2) Kennedy surgical centers where surgeries and patient care occurs. We have been approved by the CPME as a PMSR with RRA Certification "PMSR with RRA cert". Upon completion of the residency training, all graduating residents will be able to become board certified in rear foot and reconstructive ankle surgery after residency.
