The DVA Northport is co-sponsored with Stony Brook University Hospital and is a residency program that offers well-rounded residency training experiences with a wealth of in and out-patient clinical care. Extensive training in diabetic limb salvage, multidisciplinary wound care, elective and non-elective surgery, biomechanical exposure, and clinical rotations all requiring active resident participation. There is exposure to forefoot and rearfoot surgery as well as trauma, RRA surgery, elective and non-elective surgery with foot and ankle MDs and DPMs as well as training on the Podopediatric patient. 2nd and 3rd year residents spend 1 month in Mesa AZ at an affiliate at their own expense. Please be aware of this when applying. Residents spend their entire 1st year at Stony Brook University. Interested students should be aware that externships are HIGHLY encouraged. Additionally, a 250 word essay entitled "I wish to do my 3-year residency at DVA-Northport/Stony Brook because.." is required to complete your application. Email essay to Thomas.Kraemer@va.gov.
