

AACPM Announces 2019 Match Week Modification

The AACPM is pleased to announce a modification in its 2019 residency Match Week schedule. AACPM will move its Match Week from March 18-22, 2019 to March 11-15, 2019.

This change in its Match Week schedule allows the podiatry residency match to align with the National Resident Matching Program (NRMP), "The Match." By aligning the schedule, podiatric medical school graduates will celebrate Match Day on the same day as their allopathic and osteopathic peers. On Match Day, medical college graduates nationwide learn where they will begin their residency training.

"AACPM is pleased to have worked in collaboration with the National Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners (NBPME) and the American Podiatric Students Association (APMSA) to enable the CASPR Match to align with the MD/DO medical match beginning with the 2019 cycle", reports Association Board Chair, Lawrence B.
